It will be stored in a bucket that will be taken out every time we go outside. We will also wash them and replenish them with water daily.

We also ask that you keep the weather in mind as you help your child dress each morning. Mornings are still chilly, even if the high is going to be hot. We suggest that your children come to school dressed in layers. Please also check their cubbies for appropriate extra clothing as the weather has changed.
